

Cookies Policy

Our own and third-party cookies are installed on this website, in accordance with the provisions of this Policy. By configuring cookies or accepting cookies, you are authorizing the installation of only the cookies informed and configured (which were not explicitly rejected by the user). A "Cookie" is a small file that is stored on the user's computer and that allows us to recognize the user. The set of "cookies" helps us improve the quality of our website, allowing us to control which pages are useful to users. Cookies are essential for the functioning of the Internet, providing numerous advantages in the provision of interactive services, facilitating navigation and usability of our website. Please note that cookies cannot harm your computer and, in return, when they are activated, they help us identify and resolve errors. The information we provide below will help you understand the different types of cookies:

- **Session cookies:** these are temporary cookies that remain in your browser's cookie file until you leave the website, so none are registered on the user's hard drive. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyse traffic patterns on the website. Ultimately, this allows us to provide a better experience by improving content and making it easier to use.
- **Permanent cookies:** they are stored on your hard drive and our website reads them every time you visit again. A permanent website has a specific expiration date. The cookie will stop working after this date. We generally use them to facilitate purchasing and registration services. Depending on the purpose of the cookie:
- **Analysis cookies:** These are those that, duly treated by us or third parties, allow us to quantify the number of users and thus carry out statistical measurement and analysis of the use that users make of the service offered. To do this, your navigation on our website is analysed in order to improve the range of products or services we offer you.
- **Advertising cookies:** These are those that allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of advertising spaces that, where applicable, the publisher has included on a website, application or platform from which the requested service is provided based on criteria such as edited content or how often ads are shown.
- **Behavioural advertising cookies:** These are those that allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the publisher has included on a website, application or platform from which the requested service is provided. These cookies store information about user behaviour obtained through continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows the development of a specific profile to display advertising based on it. Likewise, it is possible that when you visit a website or open an email where an advertisement or promotion about our products or services is published, a cookie may be installed in your browser that helps us to subsequently show you advertising related to the research it carried out, to develop control over our advertisements in relation, for example, to the number of times they are seen, where they appear, what time they are seen, etc.
- **Technical cookies:** These are those that allow the user to navigate through a website, platform or application and use the different options or services available there, such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing parts with restricted access, remember the elements that make up an order, carry out the purchase process of an order, request registration or participation in an event, use security elements during browsing, store content for broadcasting videos or sound or sharing content through social networks.
- **Personalization cookies:** These are those that allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics depending on a series of user terminal criteria, such as the language, the type of browser through which the service is accessed, the regional configuration from which the service is accessed, etc. How to delete cookies? The user always has the possibility of accepting or rejecting the use of all cookies, or rejecting only certain

types of cookies that are not essential for the website to function. To make this modification, you can do so using the "Change your consent" link. You can allow, block or delete cookies installed on your computer by configuring the browser options installed on your computer, and if you do not allow cookies to be installed on your browser, you may not be able to access some sections of our websites. Analytical cookies are those that allow us to track and analyse the behaviour of users of our websites, including the number of pages visited, the language used, the frequency and recurrence of visits, or the time spent on each page or section, among other parameters, statistics.

Advertising cookies

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors to web pages. The intent is to display ads that are relevant and engaging to the individual user and therefore more valuable to publishers and third-party advertisers.
